"You have destroyed the country. You have milked the cow dry. You emptied the state treasury. You forced the youth to flee. Here you are, then eat our heads too."

This is the translation of a text fragment rapped by Berlin-based Miloud Messabih about his second home Algeria. In its Arabic rap part, Diwan describes the past, current and probably also future situation in Algeria from the perspective of a traveler who visits his native country once a year, if possible. Diogenes Nodarse, the most important Berlin producer of Cuban sound, raps the end of the song with an energetic part. He reports on the causes and consequences of the demonstrations that shook Cuba on June 21, 2021. For many Cubans, the day on which the Cuban political system was seriously counted for the first time.

Miloud Messabih and Diogenes Nodarse are an integral part of the Orkestra's Gentleman Group alongside David Beck, Đào Xuân Phương and Kanishka Sarkar.

The Minimal Utopia Orkestra is a follow-up ensemble of the Berlin folklore project "Heimatlieder aus Deutschland" (HaD). Many members of the Orkestra were already on stage at the first HaD performance in 2013 at the sold out Komische Oper Berlin. In the Orkestra, the artists develop their very own sound, based on their various folklore influences but also developing their own uniques style which sounds global in every way.
